The Educator Preparation Program partners with Standard for Success for our cloud-based system for student assessment and artifact storage! This is the same system used to evaluate K-12 teachers. **Every candidate as well as any student taking any EDU course or applying to the Program is required to purchase a subscription to *Standard for Success* at the cost of \$100 per academic year.** The department has adjusted our textbook requirements to make this purchase easier for our students, however, students with a financial hardship may contact Cheryl Torline for the possibility of a Panther Need Fund loan or grant via the Chaplain's Office. 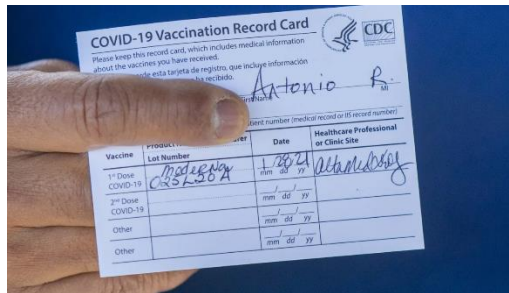


All students enrolled in an EDU course with fieldwork are required to obtain an official background check through Safe Hiring Solutions. Students will have interactions with real school children and their schools require clear background checks be submitted to them by the EPP. For this reason, ONLY purchase your Safe Hiring Solutions through our link

All students enrolled in a course with fieldwork assignments are required to upload proof of vaccination in Standard for Success. Those students without proof of vaccination will not receive a fieldwork assignment resulting in a very real deficit in their preparation to become teachers. SUBS NEEDED! Local school systems are contacting us in need of substitute teachers. This is GREAT experience for future educators. Most require an Indiana substitute certificate, and the school will assist you with that process. Call the Superintendent's office where you are interested in substituting: Madison Consolidated Schools, Southwestern Jefferson County Schools (Hanover), Scott County School - Districts 1 and 2, and Prince of Peace Catholic Schools.



The Educator Preparation Program requires formal Admission - the deadline for Sophomores to meet all requirements for admission/application is October 1. Those who do not meet all the requirements by the deadline may petition for special admission when all requirements have been met. These petitions will be considered on a case-by-case basis by the Education Department Faculty and Staff and the members of the Teacher Education Committee. Students who want to become certified teachers through the Hanover College Educator Preparation Program should refer to our website for information at <https://education.hanover.edu/prospects/> and should meet with our Education Student Services Coordinator and Education faculty members early and often!

*Special note! First Year education students who are not in EDU 221 this term should be sure to enroll in EDU 221 during the Winter term to be ready for next year's application period.
Sophomores + who are enrolled in EDU 221 this term - you must still apply and meet all other admission requirements by the deadline of Oct. 1 or follow the petition process. Student Services is happy to help you plan!*
