



Hanover College Educator Preparation Program Admission Policy

ALL SOPHOMORE APPLICATIONS ARE DUE ON OR BEFORE NOVEMBER 15, 2019.**

Admission Standards

1. EDU 221
(with positive dispositional feedback from fieldwork)
2. 2.67 minimum GPA
(GPA of 3.0 in the content area major is required prior to a student teaching assignment)
3. Clear Record with Hanover College Student Academic Assistance Committee (SAAC)
4. Clear Judicial Record with Student Life
5. Application Form through My Hanover under the Academic tab.
(Includes the uploading of the APPLICATION ESSAY, Praxis score reports, as well as RECOMMENDATION REQUESTS from two Hanover College faculty members)
6. Personal interview by Teacher Education Committee members
7. Meeting the admission exam score requirements:
ACT Reading 21.25 minimum and ACT Math 21.25 minimum (no composite).
or
SAT Reading/Writing 543.33 minimum and SAT Math 532.50 minimum (no composite)
or
PRAXIS Core
Reading Minimum score of 168.06 and Math Minimum Score of 162.14

Hanover College's **institution code is 1290** for all three admissions exams. Students admitted to Hanover College under the "test optional" process are nevertheless required to meet ONE of the exam benchmarks listed above for admission to the Educator Preparation Program. **All interested Sophomores should apply by the No. 15 deadline even if they have shortcomings in some of the requirements. The EDU faculty can then personally advise going forward.**

*Note: The Elementary Education major and the Secondary Education double major cannot be declared without Program Admission. Elementary students would be required to declare another major until admission is achieved, and then they can file for a change or additional major.

NOTE: Students are strongly encouraged to meet with an Education faculty member to fully understand the admission process for the Educator Preparation Program. Sophomores or juniors may apply for late admission after the deadline after approval from the Education faculty. Make an appointment to discuss your personal circumstances.
