### Indiana P-12 Exceptional Needs: Mild Intervention Certification

Teacher candidates must also complete either an Elementary Education (K-6) Certification or Secondary Education (P-12/5-12) Certification. Mild Interventions is not a “stand-alone” program, however it does require an additional licensing exam.
