COVID 19 REQUIREMENTS AND LIMITATIONS for EDUCATION STUDENTS

*PLEASE NOTE: All students enrolled in EDU 221 or other EDU courses with fieldwork for winter term will need a Standard for Success subscription for 2021-2022, as well as a clear Safe Hiring Solutions background check for the 2021-2022 Academic year. Students must have proof of being fully vaccinated to be allowed into a local classroom field assignment. This is uploaded into the student's Standard for Success profile as we do not have access to the College health records. A booster dose is **STRONGLY RECOMMENDED** but is not required at this time. **Students without proof of vaccination will be provided with an alternative assignment.** For more information, see the **RESOURCES** tab on our website: <https://education.hanover.edu/resources/>*



SOPHOMORE INFORMATION ADMISSION TO THE EDUCATOR PREPARATION PROGRAM

Late admission is possible for sophomores who want to pursue teacher education but who did not qualify in October. Students should have been in contact with the Education Student Services Coordinator and with the Education Department faculty for the appeal process and four-year course plan. Sophomores without formal admission at Fall Course Registration should register for other classes and then will need to add Methods (300 level) courses at DROP/ADD in the fall after formal admission in May. Do not panic...this is doable!

**Note: formal admission is also required to declare an Elementary Education or Secondary Education major.*

EDU 231 Education Law and Ethics

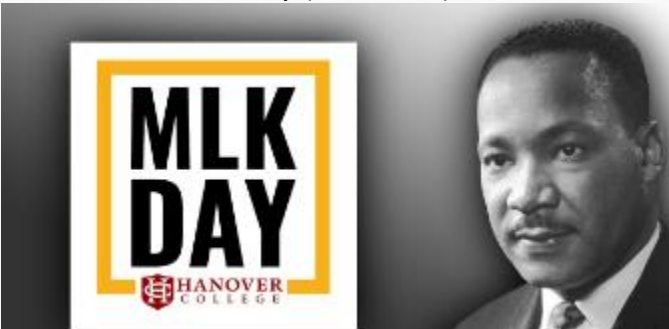

This course is currently ONLY offered by Dr. Bailey during Hanover's summer sessions, so think about your four-year plan when summer course registration opens March 7. This course can be taken in any order but must be completed prior to student teaching. Plan wisely if you still need 231!
