sophomores and higher who want to become teachers should **meet the October 1 deadline** for completed applications - wow that is TOMORROW! Apply in **Standard for Success** in your Decision Point 1 Checklist. If financial issues are preventing you from paying for your SFS subscription - talk to your professor or Cheryl Torline in EDU Student Services.

Those aspiring teachers who do not apply or who do not meet all requirements by the deadline can work with an Education professor to petition for late admission when all requirements are met. TEC will consider each petition individually. Students cannot declare an elementary education or secondary education major without a formal letter of admission by the Teacher Education Committee. Each Education student (all candidates, students enrolled in an EDU course, students applying for admission) must subscribe to *Standard for Success* at the cost of **\$100 per year**. Assignments, fieldwork, Decision Points, and other important items in EDU are all done within SFS. If you have money left in your student account, you may request a refund of that amount to cover your SFS subscription. In addition, the chaplain's office may be able to arrange a Panther Fund loan to help you in the short term, so you do not fall behind.
