Support Tickets in Standard for Success

Remember that Standard for Success has a Support Center where you can create a support ticket for any problems you may encounter in SFS. Item won't upload.? Make a support ticket - and one of the programmers will help you with your individual problem. They are usually amazingly fast to respond and if it is a technical issue, they can go in and adjust as needed to "fix" the issue!

Cheryl Torline can unlock your account if you get locked out due to too many password attempts!

The number 1 problem students have with SFS is that they are on the wrong website trying to log in! Make sure you are on the correct higher ed website: <https://edu.sfsed.com>

Reminder that students who did not have *Standard for Success* for the Fall of 2022 but are enrolled in Winter courses with fieldwork and/or who intend to apply to the program this year require an annual SFS subscription. This \$100 per academic year through August 2023. There is no "half year" subscription available. SOPHOMORE INFO FOR LATE ADMISSION TO THE EDUCATION PROGRAM

Late admission is possible for sophomores who want to pursue teacher education but who did not qualify in October. Students should be in contact with the Education Student Services Coordinator Cheryl Torline (torline@hanover.edu) and with the Education Department faculty for the appeal process and four-year course plan. Sophomores without formal admission by the Fall 2023 Course Registration March 13 – 17 should register for other classes as place holders and then will edit to add the appropriate Methods courses (300 level) during DROP/ADD in the Fall of 2023 fall after admission. **Do not panic...this is do-able!**

****Note: formal admission is also required to declare an Education major.***

EDU 231 Education Law and Ethics
